Welcome to Cogges

Cogges Manor Farm is steeped in 1,000 years of history and offers a unique glimpse into rural life in the Cotswolds.

This map is designed to help you get the most out of your visit as you explore Cogges. You might like to head over to the Stables and start with the short introductory film.

Explore

House & gardens

- Step back in time with a visit to the 13th century Manor House and immerse yourself in stories from the past.
- Wander through the enchanting walled garden and talk to volunteers who tend to it.

Farmyard

- Say hello to the animals that live on the farm and have fun feeding our goats, pigs and feathered friends with a pot of veg from reception.
- 'Meet the Animals' sessions are held at weekends and Bank Holidays.
- Discover the historic Cotswold farm buildings, including Downton Abbey's Yew Tree Farm.

Grounds

- Follow the discovery trail of 15 information points throughout the grounds to learn more about Cogges' history through time, farming heritage, food production and ancient meadows.
- Children can let off steam in the woodland adventure play areas, have a go on the zipwire, build a den or try the purpose-built climbing equipment in the meadow.

Eat & Shop

- Visit the Cogges Kitchen cafe in the old milking parlour for breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea (dogs allowed in café courtyard).
- Picnic tables are available in the toddler play area (back of cafe) or in the orchard (near the woodland adventure play).
- Our shop stocks a variety of gifts and crafts, cards and toys, Downton Abbey souvenirs, and a selection of local produce.
