Role purpose: To help us measure the success of the Cogges 1,000 Years Plus project.

What's going on at Cogges Manor Farm?

Visitors and volunteers at Cogges will start to notice some real differences to the way we tell the story of this 1,000 years of history at Cogges, alongside some much-needed improvements on site including a bespoke volunteer room and new Land Management Plan.

How can you support the project?

In order to measure how successful our new approaches and ventures have been, we will need to survey how the project has changed people's experiences of Cogges, looking at data such as the number of people who visit and where they come from, as well as their views on the new interpretation and programme of activities.

The task involves:

- Signing up to some two-hour slots over the next few weeks
- Approaching visitors near the end of their visit
- Selecting a cross-section of visitors asking them to scan a QR code with their smart phones which will give them access to a short survey
- Note taking to record additional comments given by visitors

You will be required to attend a short online training session, tbc.

Please note that you may be working in areas around the site which could involve extremes of weather!

We estimate that volunteers will be asked to work for about two hours per session, the number of sessions depending on how many volunteers we can recruit. The sessions will cover some weekdays and weekends depending on your availability.

You do not need prior experience – just a friendly approach.
